**CITY MANAGER'S REPORT**

- New City Logo – Mr. Fiscus said Mr. James provided history on the City's logo. The logo hanging in Council Chambers is one version and in 2011 a Committee recommended a new logo which included "Live, Work & Grow" and it was adopted by Council but never fully implemented by the City. This logo is used on City letterhead but is not ideal to put on a uniform patch. New proposed logos were passed out to Council (see attached). The proposed logo has gone through nine revisions after talking with stakeholders, city departments and developers. Mr. Fiscus suggested sending the logo to City employees as a survey and requesting feedback. If a new logo is adopted, it needs to be seen on vehicles, uniforms and in Council Chambers. After feedback is received, a proposed new logo will be brought to Council next month for a vote. Mr. Sizer asked about the cost of implementing a new logo. Mr. Fiscus said this has been considered and it will need to be a smoothed-in process as new uniforms and vehicles are purchased, they will show the new logo. Mr. Sizer suggested a public poll for feedback.
