Dave McLaren, 1113 Haig Street; Mr. McLaren asked the amount of tax revenue lost when the bank building was demolished. Jason Tomko will look up the information and provide it to Mr. McLaren.

Mr. McLaren asked who takes care of street lights. Mr. Fiscus said Kerry Peterson is notified of street light issues which she reports to Penn Power. Mr. McLaren said the light on Spencer Avenue between Griswold Street and the Freeway is out. Mr. James said this can also be reported by calling 1-800-LIGHTSOUT.

Mr. McLaren asked for the time limit for spending awarded ARPA grants. Mr. Fiscus said the grant awards must be programmed by 2024 or the funds would need to be reallocated.

Mr. Fiscus said he talked to the owner 1-2 weeks ago and was told the project is in the hands of the engineers and architect.
