PUBLIC COMMENTS

Revenues:

- 310-100 Realty Transfer Tax – Mr. Fiscus said this amount was increased by \$100,00 due to a ½ percent increase in the rate. The money is shown on the expenditures side going to capital improvements. We are doing a Street Study to make sure we can start allocating money to the Streets.

Expenditures:

- Mr. Sizer commented that Fire wages decreased due to changes created by the expiration of the SAFER grant in the next few months.
- Mrs. Bundrant asked if the allocation under Parks and Recreation for Buhl Day was for candy. Jason Tomko said yes.

Other Funds Budgets:

- Liquid Fuels – Mr. Sizer asked about the ARLE Grant Project for Route 62 improvements. Mr. Tomko said this is for the removal of the traffic signal on Spencer Avenue.
- Capital Improvements Project – Mr. Sizer asked if the Silver Street Multi Modal grant was awarded. Mr. Tomko said this is in the engineering phase and we are waiting to see if we are awarded the PennDOT Grant; then we will know if alterations are needed.
- Public Safety Upgrades - City of Sharon – Mr. Sizer asked if this an LSA. Mr. Tomko said yes, it is an LSA. The grant was received and will be used to build an addition to house the fire department's laundry.
